

Die Schulsozialarbeit School Social Work

Social services are offered by the primary schools. They are available free of charge to parents, children, young people, teachers, school administrators and officials.

School social workers advise and help when social or educational problems and difficulties occur or they refer them to other school services or help programmes.

The school social service is easily accessible to children and young persons. The waiting times are short.

The objective of the school social work is to improve the personal, school-related and social well-being of the children and to support the teachers at the same time. The school social work supports continuously the school's development by intervention and activities in different areas.

School social workers are qualified in social work (social educational theory, social work or social cultural animation), have practical experience and are used to advising young persons and parents and, where necessary, suggesting further specific training.
